Thomas Eriksson Architects design Copenhagen's new landmark

Bella Sky Comwell Hotel in Copenhagen opened this week and is the largest hotel in Scandinavia. Thomas Eriksson Architects (TEA) has designed the restaurants and Sky Bar.

The hotel's two towers are designed by Danish architects 3XN and reach up to 76 meters, creating a distinctive new profile on the Copenhagen skyline. Thomas Eriksson Architects (TEA) was commissioned to design the restaurants and Sky Bar.

- Our objective has been to invite the guests to an unexpected and personal experience, like visiting a contemporary Scandinavian home with an edge. We also wanted to bring nature in as an architectural element, decorating the lobby with a living wall and green grass, says Thomas Eriksson, CEO and creative director at TEA.

Each restaurant has its own style and ambience; the colour schemes are bright and crisp, combined with natural materials and textures. Furnishings are mainly Scandinavian classics in new colours, combined with specially designed objects.
